- We supported Europol operations in the United Kingdom and Ireland, Cyprus, Bulgaria and the Netherlands.
- We worked with Dutch police to secure the conviction of a card-sharing pirate in the Netherlands
- We sponsored the second Europol IP Crime conference in Budapest, ran a workshop and made a Plenary speech with the Spanish police
- We inaugurated the AAPA award for successful anti-piracy activity, with the winner being the Spanish Grupo de Antipirateria of the Policia Nacional and runners-up from the National Bureau of Criminal Investigation, Garda, Ireland and Europol's Intellectual Property Crime Co-ordinated Coalition
